#### Eye Care

Please ring us if you are having problems with your eyes or vision. In most cases you will be asked questions about your vision, your eyes, the impact of your vision on your daily life and your COVID-19 risk factors. We have been advised by our professional bodies to triage and prioritise those at greatest clinical need. We would like to thank you in advance for your understanding and patience during this process, which will take a little longer than usual. We may ask you to delay booking your appointment, especially if you are hoping to come in for your routine eye exam with no concerns. Everyone will be assessed on a

case by case basis, and we will make sure that you will have opportunities to express any concerns you have about your eyes and vision to the staff member, and our staff will have an understanding of whether you're at risk of problems.

Don't forget, now more than ever, we should be the first port of call if you have any new eye symptoms including pain or discomfort, red eyes, sudden changes in your vision, flashes and floaters. We are the only qualified Independent Prescribers in the area and in most cases can sort out your eye conditions without you having to see your GP or go to the hospital.

When you arrive at the practice, please knock the window or ring and we will let you in.

### Hygiene measures

We have always worked to high hygiene standards, but during this time we are of course following the strictest professional and government guidance:

- We are limiting the amount of people in the practice at once, making social distancing easier
- We are working on an "appointment only" basis to limit the amount of people in the practice
- All staff have access to personal protective equipment (PPE) - you will encounter staff wearing varying levels of PPE depending on how able they are to maintain social distancing during their work
- We are asking patients to try to attend on their own if possible and for any companions to wait outside or in their car
- Patients are asked to wear a face covering, ideally a mask, when attending the practice. We have some available if you do not have any at home
  - We have hand sanitising facilities available throughout the practice
  - Staff have undergone refresher training in hygiene and PPE
- Glasses frames are thoroughly sanitised to professional guidance between each patient

- Surfaces and equipment are cleaned across the practice after each patient and we perform two deep cleans a day



### Contact lenses

If you are a contact lens wearer, and require any advice or services, contact us to discuss. We can deliver, even if you do not have them delivered normally, just let us know.

Most contact lens assessments are being conducted over the phone at the moment, but you may be asked to come in for an assessment. Most new contact lens fits are not being carried out, but this is assessed on a case by case basis.

Of course, ensure your hand and lens hygiene is particularly good at this time. If you become unwell, please stop wearing your lenses and immediately throw away lenses that you are currently using.
